 - pursue common agenda for human rights and democratic reform.
 - build consensus on disputed or controversial areas of policy.
 - enhance the inclusiveness, pluralism and efficiency of civil society.
 - support the implementation of the [EU Action Plan on Human Rights and Democracy 2020-2024](#) and [EU guidelines on human rights](#) at local level.
- The priorities of this call for proposals are:
 - Rights of the child (Lot 1)
 - Women's rights and women's participation and voice in society (Lot 2)
 - Promotion of Human Rights in Culture and Art (Lot 3)
