## **RESEARCH TRIANGLE NANOTECHNOLOGY NETWORK**

Kickstarter Program



Proposed projects must be focused on research or preliminary development activity or educational programming in an area of nano-scale science, engineering, and/or technology. Competitive proposals should be: (1) limited in scope and (2) involve either hands-on science education, cutting-edge research, or high-risk, high-reward R&D activity with the potential to facilitate disruptive technologies

## Examples of relevant research and development activities include:

- Preliminary data collection, prototyping, or proof-of-principle studies with prospects of leading to future outside funding or investment.
- Activity that expands the scope of the applicant's existing research programs.
- • Specialized characterization or fabrication not currently funded within the scope of the applicant's existing programs.

## Examples of relevant educational programming include:

- Individual or group class projects that utilize RTNN capabilities.
- Lesson plan development featuring examples from experiments run at RTNN. Field trip experiences
