What is Stevens initiative

The Stevens Initiative is an international effort to build global competence and career readiness skills for young people in the United States and the Middle East and North Africa by growing and enhancing the field of virtual exchange.

what is virtual Exchange

Virtual exchange uses technology to connect people for education and exchange. connecting participants in different countries to help them gain global competencies, among other knowledge, skills, and abilities. The Stevens Initiative invites qualified nonprofit organizations and educational institutions to submit proposals for grants to conduct virtual exchange programs that connect young people in the United States and the Middle East and North Africa.



Virtual Exchange program types eligible for the Invitational priorities: grant

- Scaling Grants: Funds long-standing, proven programs that reach large groups of young people. These programs show promise for sustainability and continued impact on the virtual exchange field.
- Efficiency Grants: Prioritizes programs that experiment with new efficiencies to increase reach and impact. These grants present opportunities to learn about best practices for virtual exchange implementation.
- Seeding Grants: Supports new, promising virtual exchange models. These programs are likely to scale over
