• As part of the global awareness month for colon cancer, the School of Medicine organized a medical awareness event about colon cancer at the Specialty Hospital on Tuesday, March 26, 2024. This was the second event of its kind, following the first one held at the Jordan University Hospital. This initiative is aligned with the goals of Jordan University and the School of Medicine to build impactful and sustainable partnerships, serve the local community, and enhance the concepts of health awareness, preventive medicine, and disease prevention.

During the event, the participating doctors provided advice and information about colon cancer.

The students also provided a brief and simplified educational presentation about colon cancer for visitors, staff, and doctors at the hospital. They distributed informative brochures designed by the students under the guidance of the Department of Gastroenterology at the School of Medicine. The UJ-GIG team highlighted the necessity of having a national program for colon cancer



screening to detect cases early, even among individuals who do not show symptoms, in order to improve chances of recovery.

- on Tuesday, the Director-General of Jordan University Hospital, inaugurated the first awareness booth for colon cancer, organized by a team of clinical-year medical students from the School of Medicine interested in gastroenterology (UJ-GIG). The students provided a simplified explanation about cancer, highlighting the "Jordan Challenges Cancer" campaign in collaboration with the King Hussein Cancer Center, which aims to raise awareness in the local community about the importance of prevention, mental health care, and the necessity of regular early screening tests that save lives. They also emphasized the importance of combating all forms of smoking, as it is linked to about 13 types of cancer, most notably colon and rectal cancer.

This awareness booth, under the slogan "Together for Better Digestive Health," will continue throughout March, with sessions held twice a week. It aims to raise awareness about colon cancer and the essential screenings that help in its early detection, such as a colonoscopy every 10 years after the age of 50 or a fecal occult blood test, which is recommended annually after the age of 50. The booth also distributed brochures to educate the public on these matters.

The students stressed the need for a national program for colon cancer to detect people diagnosed at an early stage, even before symptoms appear, which increases the chances of successful treatment. Additionally, they highlighted the importance of detecting and removing polyps in the colon to prevent.

An Awareness Event on the Importance of Early Detection of Breast Cancer at the Jordan University Hospital

The Breast Imaging Unit at the Jordan University Hospital organized an awareness and educational event on Tuesday, in celebration of Breast Cancer Awareness Month, under the slogan "A Step Towards Life," with the attendance of the hospital's General Director. The event included a series of tables displaying educational posters and brochures about breast cancer, its prevention methods, the importance of early detection, self-examination techniques for women, and the significance of mammography for women aged 40 and above. This helps significantly in the early detection of the disease and thus increases the chances of recovery, which can exceed 95% in such cases. Additionally, appointments were provided for women to undergo mammography at the unit. The event, supported by the Jordan Breast Cancer Program and Jara Medical Devices & Supplies Company, also included the distribution of symbolic gifts and sweets to female attendees.

The procedure involves either rubbing hands with alcohol-based hand sanitizer for 20 seconds or washing them with soap and water for one minute, especially after patient contact.


