# Memorandum of Understanding

#### between

## The University of Jordan

#### and

## The University of Auckland

First Party: The University of Jordan, Amman, 11942, Jordan

Second Party: The University of Auckland, Private Bag 92019, Auckland, New Zealand

The two parties hereby propose to foster academic exchange and cooperation between the two parties and agree to the following:

- 1. The two parties will encourage the following activities in particular:
  - Exchange of materials, publications and information.
  - ii) Mobility of professors, research staff, and students.
  - iii) Acceptance by the second party of qualified graduates of the first party into PhD programmes.
  - Joint research. iv)
- 2. These activities are to be carried out after mutual consultation between the two institutions or the divisions concerned thereof. Normally each institution will sign a letter of Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) setting out the responsibilities of each institution for the agreed activity and such other matters as the institutions agree are necessary for the efficient achievement of the activity.
- 3. Amendment of this MoU is to be effected by written agreement of the two institutions. No such amendment or revision will come into effect until both institutions have agreed in writing to this amendment or revision
- 4. This MoU shall be effective upon approval by both parties and shall remain in effect for a period of five years. Thereafter, subject to a review by each institution which confirms the MoU is achieving the objectives set out above, it shall be automatically renewed from year to year. However, after the initial period either institution may terminate the MoU at the end of a given academic year by giving six months notice in writing of such intent, provided that termination by one party shall not affect any activities already approved under this MoU.
