The Research Triangle Nanotechnology Network (RTNN) is a collaboration between North Carolina State University, Duke University, and the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill that offers open access to comprehensive and unique nanotechnology laboratories, equipment, and research expertise. the RTNN has established a Kickstarter program to allow members of the nanotechnology and greater scientific communities to use RTNN facilities.

Externally Funded Projects Department encourages you to submit proposals at preliminary development activity or educational programming, in an area of nano-scale science, engineering, and/or technology.

## COMPETITIVE PROPOSALS SHOULD BE

- limited in scope.
- involve either hands-on science education, cutting-edge research, or high-risk, high-reward R&D activity with the potential to facilitate disruptive technologies.

## EXAMPLES OF EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMING

- Individual or group class projects that utilize RTNN capabilities.
- Lesson plan development featuring examples from experiments run at RTNN.
- Field trip experiences.
