- PROJECT FACTS

ICT4EDU is a 3-years projects that started on January 2023, and is co-funded by the Erasmus+ program of the European Union. It's coordinated By The University of Jordan (UJ) with 12 partners from Europe and MENA regions.

The project (ICT4EDU) aims to ensure that newly graduated student teachers are able to employ ICT in teaching, and to improve the digital literacy of teachers and students, especially in dealing with children with special educational needs or disabilities as ICT plays a key role in facilitating their educational process.

The main objective of the (ICT4EDU) project is to improve the quality of ICT competencies of early childhood teacher's educators in the (9) higher education institutions in Jordan, Palestine and Egypt in line with the advanced EU practices, and thereby increase the quality of education in preschools in Jordan, Palestine and Egypt.

The cross-national implementation of the (ICT4EDU) project is essential for defining practices and influencing policies and curricula in schools of education and integrating ICT teacher training to meet the needs of digitally literate youth and children.



CAPACITY BUILDING AND TRAINING WORKSHOPS (TEACHER/TECHNICIAN STAFF AND STUDENTS)



Lead : Instituto Politecnico Do Porto (IPP) Co-lead :P6- Heliopolis University (HU

This WP intends for developing PC HEIs' Teaching staff innovative and technology-enhanced ICT skills and Developing Early Childhood Curricula (Design of learning and Teaching Materials). Back from TOT courses the trained trainers will adjust TOTs to the local needs and organize in-house teacher training (TT) courses. Each couple of trainers will train at least a group of (10) teachers in their HEIs with the active support from EU partners.

Based on predefined selection criteria will be defined by the quality committee in total (40) teaching staff) will be trained per (2) TOT rounds in Europe.


ICT laboratories devoted to development and implementation of courses prepared during project realization will be established at each partner university.
