This Memorandum of Understanding is made on this 20/6/2019.

UNIVERSITY OF JORDAN (hereinafter referred to as "JU"), whose address is amman-11942- Jordan represented by its president or designated officer. and LUSAIL EDUCATIONAL ORGANIZATION (hereinafter referred to as "LEO"), whose address is at Lusail District, Doha, QATAR and shall include its lawful representatives and permitted assigns; (hereinafter referred to singularly as "the Party" and collectively as "the Parties",

WHEREAS

- A. JU is a public university of higher education situated amman-jordan. It was created in 1962. The study is primarily conducted in Arabic and English. Other languages such as English, Spanish, Russian, Chinese etc are also taught as courses. Consisting of institutions located in amman the University offers a variety of programs for undergraduates, Master's and Doctorate students almost in all study fields. The offerings of the university in terms of programmes and courses are: 76 BA courses, 114 MA courses, Engineering courses. courses of business and management schools programmes of medical doctorate, a. Doctoral programmes.
- B. LEO is a fully private educational institute situated in the heart of the newly established district of Lusail in Doha city the capital of QATAR. LEO was founded very recently to establish LUSAIL University LU in Qatar. The founders of the LEO look forward to establishing the first four colleges under Lusail University upon Ministry of Education and Higher Education approval. LEO intends to conduct a variety of university degree, Masters and Doctoral programmes in Arabic and English as well.

C. The Parties are desirous of entering into this Memorandum of Understanding to declare their respective intentions and to establish a basis of co-operation and collaboration between the Parties upon the terms as contained herein.

HAVE REACHED AN UNDERSTANDING as follows:

ARTICLE I OBJECTIVE

The Parties, subject to the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding and the laws, rules, regulations and national policies from time to time in force in each Party's country, will endeavor to strengthen, promote and develop particularly in academic and research co-operation between the Parties on the basis of equality and mutual benefit.

ARTICLE II AREAS OF CO-OPERATION


The Parties shall endeavor to adopt and implement programmes developed and accredited by JU in Qatar through the university which will be established by LEO. The graduates from those above mentioned programmes in Qatar will be offered JU' diplomas and certificates. The language of instruction of the programmes is Arabic and English languages. - 2.1. Exchange of documentation, faculty, staff and/or students
- 2.2. Development of collaborative research projects.
- 2.3. Working to sign twinning agreements between scientific departments or centers with similar specialties in the universities and educational institutions of both institutions.
- 2.4. Organization of joint academic and scientific activities.
- 2.5. Exchange of publications, reports and other academic materials of common interests.



2.6. Any other areas of co-operation to be mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

ARTICLE III

Finance

- 3.1. Neither institution shall incur any financial obligations under this Memorandum of Understanding (beyond the registration fees and any other financial obligation that will be agreed upon by both parties, which will be signed on in separate agreement). Applications for financial support towards the co-operation and individual activities planned under this agreement will be transparent and undertaken with mutual consent.
- 3.2. Other sources of finances raised to support these joint projects can be pursued with the knowledge of the other through intimation in writing.

ARTICLE IV

EFFECT OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding serves only as a record of the Parties' intentions and does not constitute or create, and is not intended to constitute or create, obligations under domestic or international law and will not give rise to any legal process and will not be deemed to constitute or create any legally binding or enforceable obligations, express or implied.

ARTICLE V ENTRY INTO EFFECT AND DURATION

5.1. This Memorandum of Understanding will come into effect on the date of signing and will remain in effect for a period of **five (5)** years with the understanding that either party may terminate this Memorandum of Understanding with **twelve (12)** months notice unless an earlier termination is mutually agreed upon.



5.2. This Memorandum of Understanding may be extended for a further period as may be agreed in writing by the Parties.

ARTICLE VI CONFIDENTIALITY

Each Party shall undertake to observe the confidentiality and secrecy of documents, information and other data received from or supplied to, the other Party during the period of the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding or any other agreements made pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding.

ARTICLE VII SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

Any difference or dispute between the Parties concerning the interpretation and/or implementation and/or application of any of the provisions of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be settled amicably through mutual consultation and/or negotiations between the Parties through diplomatic channels, without reference to any third party or international tribunal.

ARTICLE VIII NOTICES
